- 5. Make goals attainable so students can be successful. Then make the goal gradually more difficult. Reward all students for reaching the school goal (possibly 5 minutes of extra recess or cake at lunch?).
- 6. Simplify the goal to attendance only, not early checkouts.
- 7. Reward for perfect attendance each term and full year.
