 - GOAL #1: Based on Acadience Reading Middle of Year (MOY) data, 78% of Lakeside Elementary Students in grades K-3 will make "Typical" or better progress according to Acadience Pathway of Progress Composite score
 - GOAL #2Lakeside Elementary Students will show growth based on the school average MGP (Median Growth Percentile) at least 1 additional percentile from 58% to 59% from the most recent year's state summative testing in all academic areas as measured by the 2022 state summative assessment. This includes language arts, math, and science.
 - Goal #3 By using student mentors and instruction, Lakeside will increase the number of students at Benchmark by 1% based off of the end of year CRTs in Grades K-2, and on Math and ELA Rise Testing in grades 3-6.
